National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct the NEET Exam for UG Medical Education :

- NEET candidate should be an Indian National or OCI (overseas citizen of India) and Aadhaar card is mandatory for all candidates except belonging to Assam, J & K and Meghalaya State.
- Assam, J & K and Meghalaya candidates can also apply for NEET by providing their passport number, ration card number, bank account number or any other valid Government ID number.
- PIO, OCI & Foreign national's candidates can apply by passport number. Minimum Age - The minimum age limit is 17 years on 31st December of the year of admission. Maximum Age-There is no maximum age limit for NEET exam.
- There is no maximum attempt limit for writing the NEET exam. Students must have passed/appearing 12th or equivalent examination from any recognized board with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology or any other elective subject with English.
- Students of 12th level must have Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology with English as a mandatory subject. Candidates in the 12th level must have secured minimum 50% marks for General categories; 45% marks for PH and 40% marks for SC/ST category candidates in PCB group.





The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India has entrusted the responsibility of conducting Joint Entrance Examination JEE (main) to the National Testing Agency (NTA) from 2019 onwards.

Admission criteria to undergraduate engineering programs at NITS, IITs, other centrally Funded Technical Institution (CFTI), Institutions funded by participating state Governments and other Institutions shall include the performance in the class 12th/ equivalent qualifying Examination and in the Joint Entrance Examination JEE (main).

The (B.E. / B. Tech.) of JEE (main) will also be an eligibility test for the JEE (Advanced), which the candidate has to take if he/she is aspiring for admission to the undergraduate offered by programs the Indian Institute of Technology (IITs).

The JEE (main) will be conducted twice before admission in the next academic session. The student's best of the two NTA scores will be considered for preparation of Merit list / Ranking.

JEE (MAIN) Eligibility

Age Limit / Qualifying exam- For appearing in the JEE (main) examination there is no age limit for the candidates. The candidates should also satisfy themselves about their fulfilling the age limit requirements of the Institutes in which they are desirous of taking admission. The candidates must note that the IITs have an age limit / restriction.





MHT CET (or Maharashtra Common Entrance Test) is a common state level entrance exam conducted by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra every year for admission to Undergraduate Engineering, Pharmacy and Agriculture courses such as B. Tech/ B.E, Pharma D And B.Pharma offered at colleges in Maharashtra.

The examination will be conducted at various centres across the Maharashtra as well as outside Maharashtra State by Online mode (Computer Based Test) for PCM and PCB group separately.

MHT-CET Eligibility Criteria

All aspirants who have passed / appeared in the qualifying examination i.e., HSC/12th Standard examination or its equivalent examination and having Indian Nationality are eligible for appearing for MHT CET. There is no age limit for appearing in MHT-CET.

- For PCM - This paper is having 2 Groups of Physics-Chemistry and Mathematics with total 180 minutes duration; for first 90 minutes, Physics and Chemistry will be enabled and after completion of first 90 minutes time, Physics-Chemistry group will be auto submitted and Mathematics group will be enabled with 90 minutes' duration.
- For PCB - This paper is having 2 Groups of Physics-Chemistry and Biology with total 180 Minutes Duration, first 90 minutes Physics and chemistry will be enabled and only after completion of time response for Physics -Chemistry group will be auto submitted and Biology group will be enabled with 90 minutes' duration.



NATA (NATIONAL APTITUDE TEST IN ARCHITECTURE)

Eligibility Criteria: Candidate should have passed an 10+2 examination with at least 50 percent aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50 percent marks in aggregate.

Cognitive skills for Drawing and visual composition Test (Part-A)

Candidate has to attempt 10 questions (Preferential Type/MCQ) within 72 minutes on PC/laptop. The drawing aptitude is judged on the following aspects. Understanding the important visual principles in a composition (2D OR 3D) such as balance, rhythm, direction, hierarchy, etc. Understanding geometry and the ability to visualize shape and solve geometrical puzzles to test spatial intelligence, Understanding color theory and the various terminologies to test color scheme knowledge. Visual system interpretation and perception to test graphical similarities and other properties. Ability to understand spatial relation- ship between objects, and to visualize images. Tests for cognitive ability: perception, attention, recognition, memory etc.

Test on PCM and General Aptitude (Part-B)

There shall be 50 questions to be answered on PC/laptop within 45 minutes. Each question shall have 4 options out of which, only one option is correct. Each correct response will yield 1.5 marks. There is no negative marking.



NEET PG

- The National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Postgraduate) (or NEET (PG)) also called Foreign Medical Graduate Examination is a qualifying and ranking examination in India, for students who wish to study various postgraduate Doctor of Medicine (MD), Master of Surgery (MS) and diploma courses, in government or private medical colleges in the country.
- This exam replaced All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination (AIPGMEE).
- The exam is conducted by the National Board of Examinations (NBE). The counselling and seat allotment is conducted by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidates studying in India, having Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) degree or provisional MBBS pass certificate as per Indian Medical Council Act, and MBBS registration certificate issued by the Indian or state medical council and have completed one year of internship or will be completing the internship, are eligible to apply for the exam.
- The candidates having Indian citizenship, but have graduated from any foreign medical college, should qualify the Medical Council of India Screening Test (also called Foreign Medical Graduate Examination).
- For foreign nationals, registration is necessary from the country they have obtained basic medical qualification. Medical Council of India (MCI) registration is not compulsory. Temporary registration might be given on payment of application fees.



SPECIALIZATION AFTER MBBS

- The country produces the largest number of documents in the world and when students prefer specialization after MBBS the seats are even less than number of MBBS seats.
- 15 lakh candidates competing for approximately 83,075 seats each year, while the competition at the UG level is tough and also admission to PG courses is also tough.
- Postgraduate Medical Degrees - Important Skills.
- Candidates must decide their PG medical degree they want to go for before choosing the specialization after MBBS.
- PG Diploma Courses - 2 years.
- PG Medical Degree - 3 years.
- (Doctor of medicine) MD is PG Degree in general medicine while (Masters of surgery) MS is qualification in surgery.

MD (DOCTOR OF MEDICINE)

MD Medicine is a 3 year (including one year of internship) postgraduate course that studies medicine in detail. MD Medicine is the future prospect of the MBBS candidates, who have completed the 5-year 6 months training in medical subjects. In the course of this study, prevention, diagnosis and treatment of adult diseases.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



- Candidates must hold a valid MBBS degree from one of India's or abroad recognized medical colleges or institutes.
- Admission to all medical courses in India is based on the results of the NEET entrance examination. Because MD is a postgraduate degree, candidates must have a NEET-PG score/rank in order to be admitted to one of the MD specializations in India.
- The minimum aggregate score requirement in the qualifying examination varies by college; therefore, all candidates should review the eligibility criteria outlined by the college of their choice.

MS (Master of Surgery) is a three-year-long postgraduate course that deals with human body parts, diseases and different surgical techniques to treat and prevent diseases. Globalization has led to exponential growth in the medical industry.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



- Admission for the Master of Surgery course in India begins with checking the course's eligibility criteria, including a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in MBBS in any reputed University or Institution.
- Additionally, a passing score is required on the necessary entrance exams. This course is open to all ages.

POST MBBS DNB



- Diplomate of National Board (DNB) is a Post-graduate Master's degree same as MD/MS degree awarded to the Specialist Doctors in India after completion of three-year residency.
- It is equal to Doctorate of Medicine (DM) and Master of Chirurgiae (MCh) degrees awarded respectively in medical and surgical super specialities.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidates are required to have a medical degree and those who already possess a permanent registration certificate provisioned by the Medical Council of India can apply for the DNB course.
- Also candidates must have completed a one-year internship successfully before filling the application form.

MBA (MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION)

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) is an internationally-recognized degree designed to develop the skills required for careers in business and management. An MBA can also be useful for those pursuing a managerial career in the public sector, government, private industry and other areas.



MBA ENTRANCE CRITERIA

- The basic eligibility criteria for MBA (full-time) are graduation in any discipline or equivalent from a recognized university
- Most of the institutes follow the minimum score criteria in Graduation which is 50 percent in average or equivalent.
- For Reserved category students, the minimum score is 45 percent in aggregate.
- Final-year graduation candidates are also eligible to apply for MBA, provided they present the proof of completion of Graduation degree within the duration specified by the institute.
- Professionals with CA/CS/ICWAI and other degrees can also pursue MBA.
